What is this p	product?
Product	HOPLON FUND Ltd (the "HOPLON FUND") is an Alternative Investment Fund addressed to a limited number of persons. The fund is authorized by the Cyprus Securities and Exchange Commission (license number LPAIF99/2014), to operate as an open-ended Variable Capital Investment Company as provided in the Cyprus AIF Law L 124(I)/2018. The fund incorporated as a company under the Companies Law, Cap. 113 on the 29th of December 2017, with registration number HE378244 in the form of a private company limited by shares
Objectives	The fund aims to achieve above average risk-adjusted returns by combining the qualitative and quantitative expertise of the Manager of the Fund and of the fund Directors by investing in a diversified portfolio qualifying as assets not subject to custody, including investing in shares of non-listed companies, start-ups and making investments in real estate. The Fund may also invest in any other investments and securities non subject to custody that the Directors may determine from time to time in their sole discretion. The target market of the Company is global with particular focus on Cyprus, Europe and Eastern Europe Adverse impacts of investment decisions on sustainability factors are not considered due to the lack of available information at the moment which prevents a proper like-to-like comparison between investments in terms of the ESG factors and because this limits the range of available investments under consideration and thus reduces diversification.

What are the risks and what could I get in return?

- The risk indicator assumes you keep the product for 5 years as per recommended holding period.
- The product is considered as illiquid.
- The actual risk can be significantly higher than the one represented in the Risk Indicator if you cash in at an earlier stage.
